Quiz (6-8 years)

1. You should never say 'no' to your friends.

Answer: False

It IS okay to say 'no' (even to your friends) if you feel uncomfortable about something.

2. Listen to your teachers – it is their job to help you.

Answer: True

You SHOULD listen to your teacher. They are a trusted person who can help you.

3. You should never leave school with someone you don't know.

Answer: True

NEVER EVER leave school with someone you don't know. If no one has come to pick you up, find a teacher or go to the front office.

4. It's okay to break the rules when you're at school and your parents aren't around.

Answer: False

The school rules ARE there to keep you safe and it is your responsibility to follow them.

5. If someone hurts themselves on the playground, see if they are okay and get a teacher if you need extra help.

Answer: True

Seeing if they are okay and fetching a teacher IS the responsible thing to do.

6. It is normal to always be unhappy at school.

Answer: False

School SHOULD be a place where everyone has fun and feels safe and happy.

7. You do not need to look after your school or keep it clean – you don't live there!

Answer: False

Just because you don't live there, DOESN'T mean you don't have to look after it. Be responsible by cleaning up after yourself.

8. It is important to memorise your Mum and Dad's phone number, home address and Triple 000.

Answer: True

That's right. It IS a good idea to memorise Triple 000, your Mum and Dad's mobile number and home address, and the number of a close family friend to call if you are in trouble.
